And according to recent national threat assessment of this growing, mobile street gang, they could be operating in your community...now or in the near future.</i><br><i><b>MS-13 members engage in a wide range of criminal activity</b>, including drug distribution, murder, rape, prostitution, robbery, home invasions, immigration offenses, kidnapping, carjackings/auto thefts, and vandalism. Most of these crimes, you'll notice, have one thing in common—they are exceedingly violent. And while most of the violence is directed toward other MS-13 members or rival street gangs, innocent citizens often get caught in the crossfire.</i> | Golden West |
